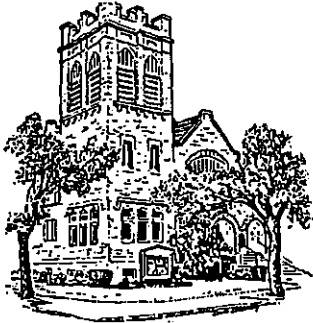

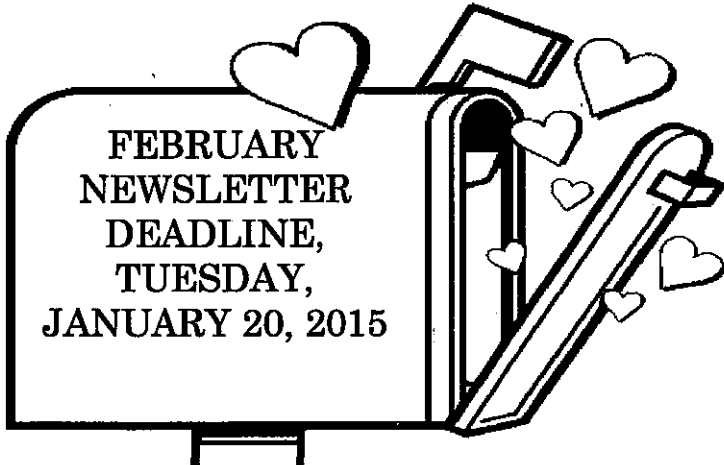

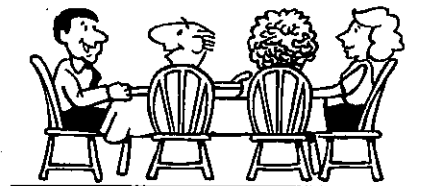

FUMC FINANCE UPDATE—NOVEMBER 30, 2014

In November the General Fund saw an increase of over \$8,200, ending at a balance of -\$794. The gain was attributable to several factors:

- Thanksgiving offerings: \$4,745
- Turkey dinner proceeds: \$2,058
- Savings from foregoing November mission share payment: \$2,000



November's regular stewardship income was \$14,799. This was the highest income since February, but is still about \$1,000 short of the average monthly amount required to meet budgeted expenses.

The Finance Committee is hopeful that Christmas offerings in December help create further increases in the General Fund, and will pay as much as we prudently can to the conference in lieu of our regular mission share payments for October through December.

The Finance Committee and Church Council passed a 2015 budget that includes over \$12,000 in budget cuts, which accounts for roughly half of the deficit we experienced this year. The committee hopes that the other half of the deficit can be made up by increased stewardship as we move into and through 2015. Keep in mind that increased stewardship can not only be accomplished through increased offerings from current churchgoers, but also through growing our congregation. All of us have the power to contribute to at least one of these goals in some way. May we enjoy success in both of these areas in 2015.

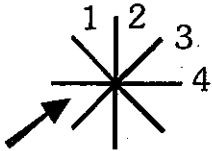

1. Crisscross straws.

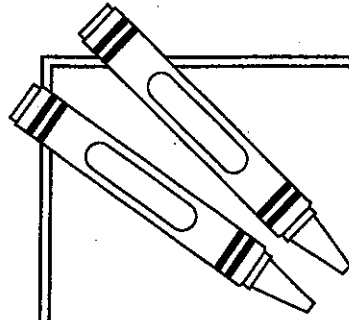
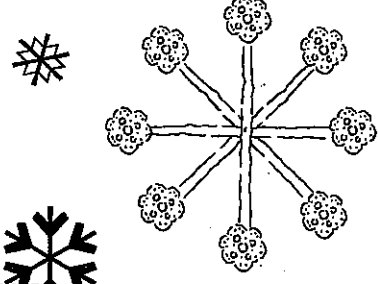


2. Staple in the center where they all cross (can use tape if needed).

5. Hang with a piece of string.

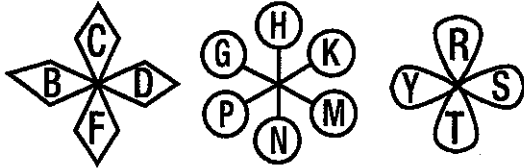
