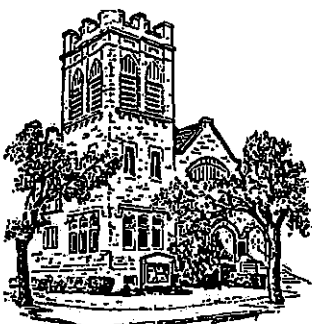

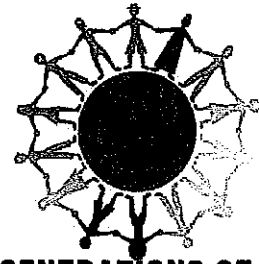

NEW GENERATIONS OF FAITH
2016 - ...!

Good Morning *Sweetcakes*!!

Last month I shared a poem with you. I also asked for your feedback regarding what you thought about my poem. I am so happy to say that there have been a few people that have told me how they felt when they read the poem. The poem was *God Says Yes To Me* by Kaylin Haught.

I shared that poem for three reasons:

1. I really wanted to hear from you! Thank you to everyone who came to me with comments.
2. In that poem, I heard God saying to us, "Be yourself."
3. In that poem, we are reminded that some people may relate to God in a different way than you and I do.

Please note—God is still God and He is revealed to us through Scripture as Father. God is still God and He is revealed through Scripture using male pronouns. God is still God and Jesus is the Son of God. Here comes the challenge, what if someone was to relate to God using motherly instincts that are also inherent in God? Have you ever felt that way? Guess what, some people have and I just want us to know that it is okay. Also, what if we revealed ourselves to God in a very vulnerable way—that is, we were to be ourselves? The unique part of that question is this—God already knows who we are and how we feel about certain things and to deny those feelings before God would be a denial of our true selves.

In the book *Unchristian*, the author gathered research from the Barna Group that revealed that the number one perception of those outside the church is that Christians say one thing but live entirely different.

I want to begin to challenge each of us to start living a new perception in 2017. What if Christians were transparent about their flaws and acted first and talked second?

In 2017, we are planning to make intentional efforts to connect with the world around the church. It will be easy to be judgmental, critical, and dare I say hypocritical. It will be a challenge to us all to open ourselves up to God and to others with transparency and honesty. As we find ourselves trying to connect with the world around us, we must honestly say to ourselves that an authentic Christian is one who simply has made the decision to believe in Jesus as their forgiver and then make the change to follow Jesus as their leader.

"Simply put, we must stop presenting ourselves as the message and begin presenting Jesus as the message. There will be disappointment with Christians as long as there are imperfect people. Since all Christians are imperfect, there will always be disappointment. So we must stop having the message of Christ tied to our butchered efforts" (*Unchristian*, page 60).

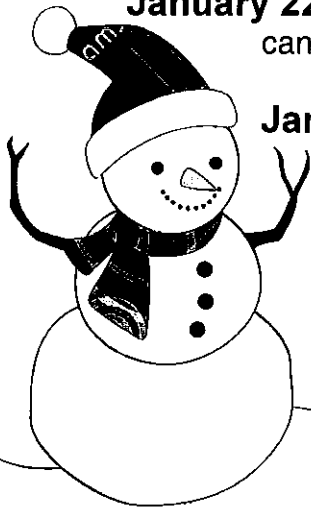

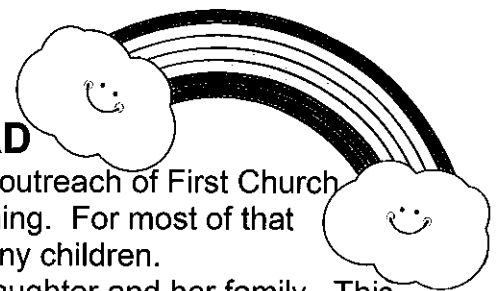
CHANGES AT RAINBOW ROAD

madness.

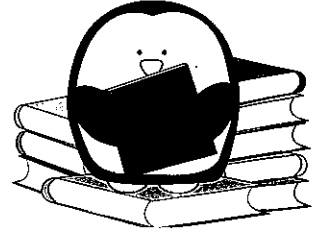

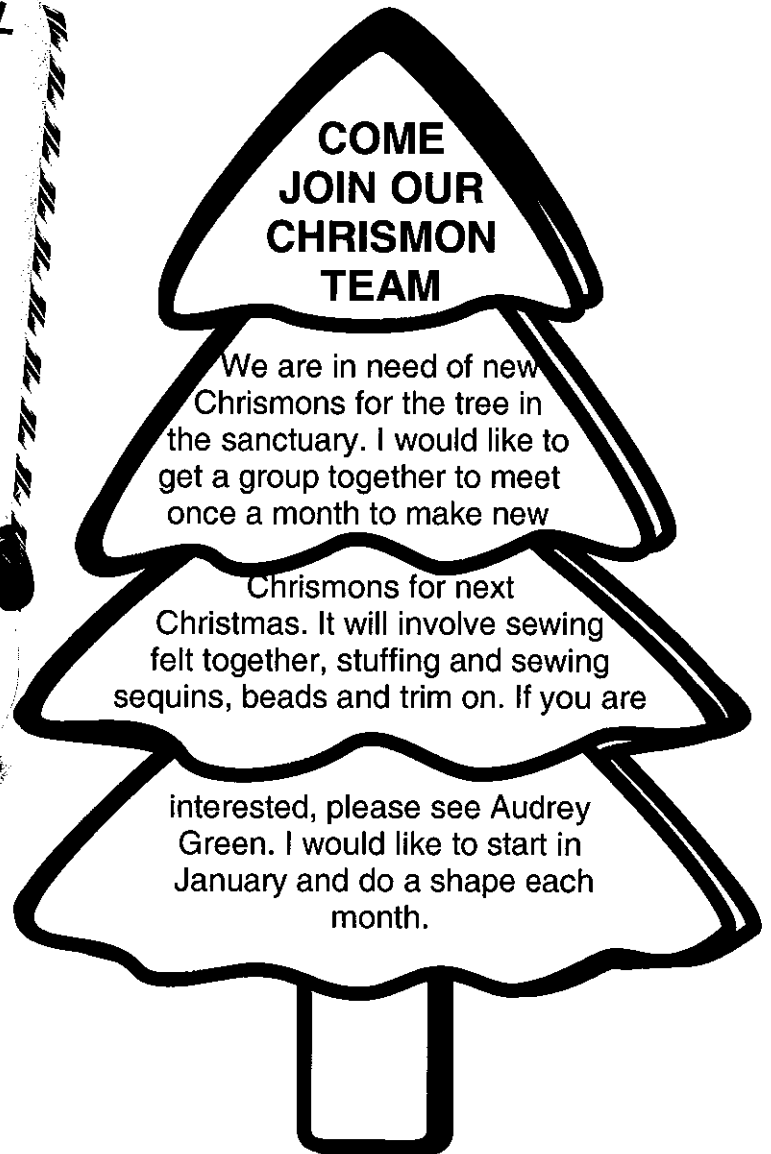

Recently I was accepted with World Gospel Mission to serve as a Volunteer In Action in Egypt. 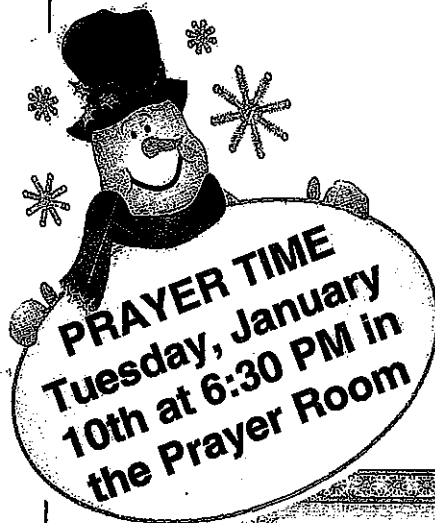

2017 VBS CANS

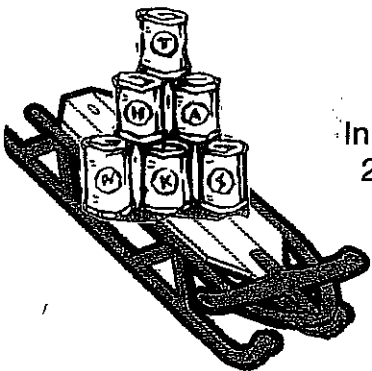

Our collection for VBS 2017 continues-so-KEEP THEM COMING!

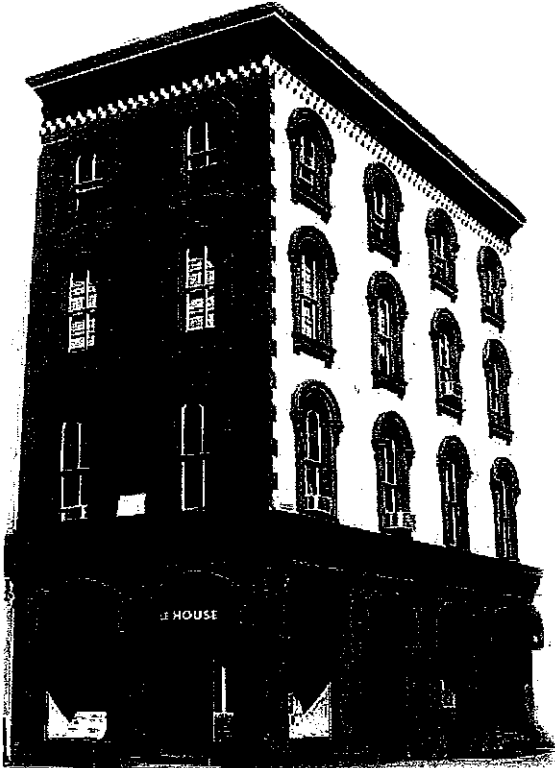

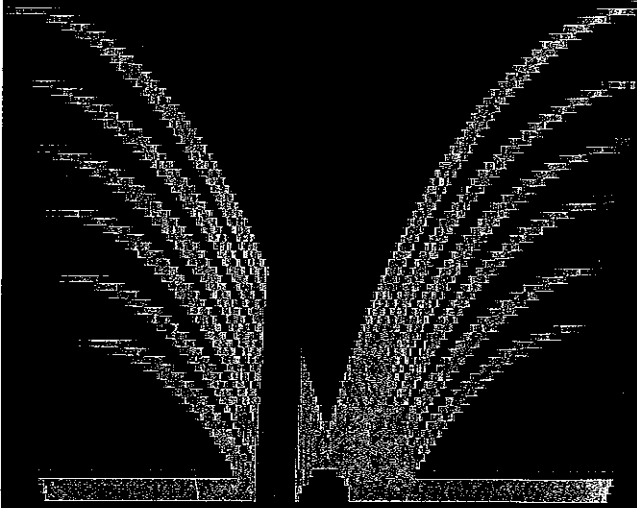

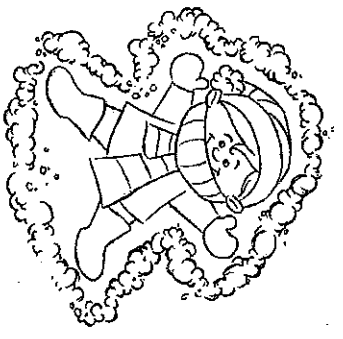
